

### **Chief Complaint (CC)**

22-year-old female who presented with lower extremity swelling and abdominal pain

### **History of Present Illness (HPI)**

- Lower extremity swelling and abdominal pain
- Diffuse lymphadenopathy, scattered pulmonary lesions, and some bone lesions

### **Test Results Observed**

- PET/CT scan demonstrated uptake in multiple lymph node stations including the axilla, the hilum and the abdomen
- Albumin of 2.7; Alkaline phosphate at 153
- Normal creatinine
- Leukocytosis with a white blood cell count of 25.7 that was left-shifted
- Anemia; Hemoglobin of 9.4
- Platelet count of 581,000
